#### **Organist's Notes**

Abraham Lincoln signed the *Emancipation Proclamation* on January 1, 1863, freeing the slaves in the Confederacy states. However, The American Civil War effectively ended at Appomattox Court House, Virginia, where Confederate General Robert E. Lee surrendered his Army of Northern Virginia to Union General Ulysses S. Grant on April 9, 1865, thus allowing for the freeing of slaves. The *Emancipation Proclamation* didn't affect slaves who lived in the border states that remained loyal to the Union. With the ending of the American Civil War, it took until June 19, 1865 to get the word to all areas of the United States.

**Juneteenth**, as it is known now, officially freed all slaves. President Joe Biden made Juneteenth a National Holiday. Bruce Jeffries met Calvin Taylor at the North Central Regional Conference of the American Guild of Organists in 2023. The music chosen for today's worship service is in honor of Juneteenth 2026.
